# Grab and Go Pets Pack

Ask mum or dad to help you collect the things you would need to move your pets. You could store them in a box in the garage or shed.

- Cages or pet carriers for each animal
- Leash or lead rope and head collar for each animal
- 3-7 days of food and water for each animal
- Bowl or feed bucket
- Can opener and spoon
- Woollen blanket, towels or bedding
- Animal medications and first aid items
- Litter and litter tray for cats
- Poo bags for animals
- Toys
- Documentation eg: Veterinary details, registration and photos of your animals
