

Make **safe decisions** during a flood



Check the latest warnings

- Visit the NSW SES website for current information.
- Check the Hazards Near Me app.
- Listen to radio and TV for information, updates and advice.
- Share information about floods with family, friends and neighbours.



Act safely

- Follow all advice from emergency services.
- Never walk, ride or drive through floodwater. Never play in floodwater.
- Go to the safe place you identified outside the flood risk area or to an evacuation centre.



Monitor local conditions

- Check for road closures at the Live Traffic website.
- Stay away from flooded areas.



If you stay

If you are trapped by flood, seek shelter in the highest part of a sturdy building or on high ground and call **Triple Zero (000)** for rescue. This is a life-threatening situation.
